Health and Safety is embedded in our culture at FRC, Inc. both as a company and on our project locations. We work through our safety manuals with them, so they understand all our safety protocols and practices. At our earliest opportunity we get them any needed training to cover their scope of work for the project. After this initial training, we manage our safety training matrix by employee and provide the needed training on a quarterly basis to keep employees certified/trained. We also encourage elective safety training courses for all our staff, which are fully funded by FRC, Inc.

In 2020, we proactively added a Compliance Manager to our team, whom we acquired in February 2020, from UCSF Medical Center, where he worked for 13 years. For 4 of those 13 years, he spent time managing in an environment where he had to prevent workers or himself from encountering lethal diseases, while also protecting bystanders around hospital jobsites. He is fully trained in infection control protocols and jobsite disinfecting procedures by working with EH&S (Environment, Health, and Safety). As our Compliance Manager, he oversees all safety guidelines for our jobsites and all training requirements in conjunction with our project site superintendents. Please see attached resume.


