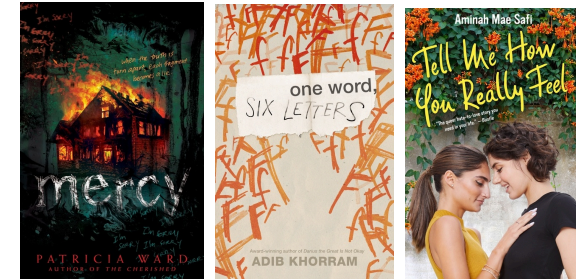
### Huda F Wants to Know?

When her parents announce they are divorcing, Huda Fahmy struggles to keep her plans on track for junior year.

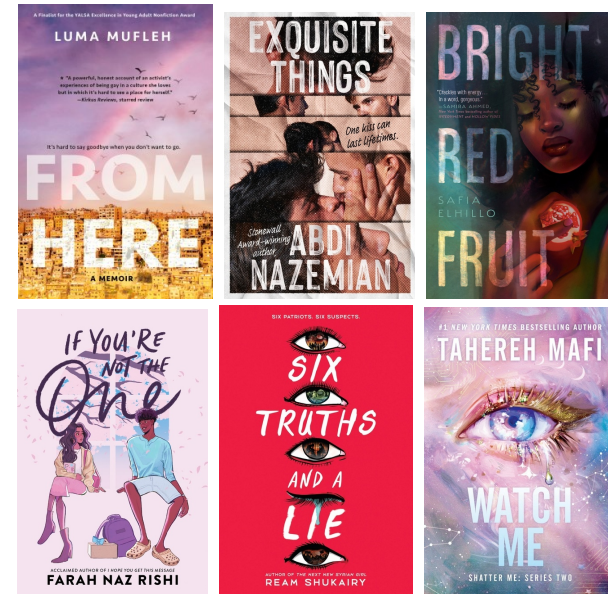


### Squire

by Safia Elhillo (she/her) - Y ELHILLO

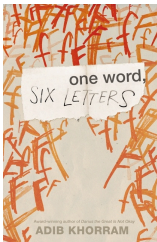
A coming-of-age novel-in-verse about a teenager's journey into the slam poetry scene and the dangerous new relationship that could threaten all her dreams.
