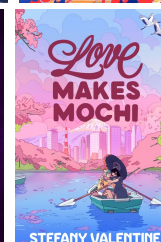
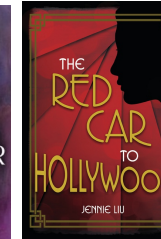
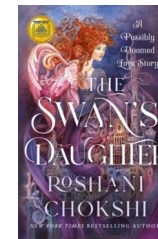


Tall Water

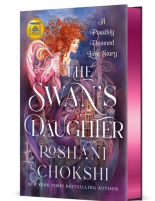

by Emiko Jean (she/her) - Y JEAN

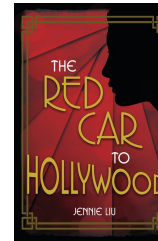
When seventeen-year-old Emma wishes for proof that love is real, she starts receiving letters from her true love in the future and attempts to uncover the identity of the sender in the past.
