by Isaac Blum (he/him) - Y BLUM

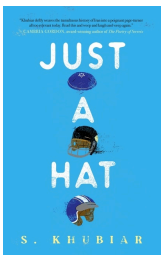

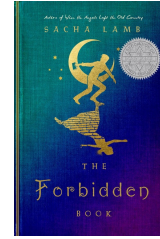
