
## This is My Library The Cloverdale Library






## This is my library's entrance.

## This is the children's librarian at my library.





### These are the times I can use my library.






## I must respect other people in the library.





## This is how I find a book at my library.




I can look for books in my library's computer catalog. I can search by title or author or subject. I can do this on computers at the library or from home.

This is a library card.



Having a library card at my library lets me check out things like books, DVDs, CDs, movies and music. There are rules about getting and using a library card. A librarian can provide me with more information about getting and using my library card.

My library has a children's area with many materials for different ages.



I can find books, music, audio books, tablet computers, computers, DVDs, and video games here.

There are bathrooms in the hallway at the library that I can use.

# There is a water filling station and drinking fountain at the library if I get thirsty.
